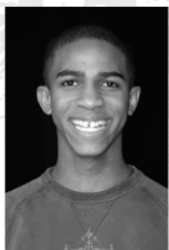
JORIE JOHNSON (SISTER CHANTELLE)

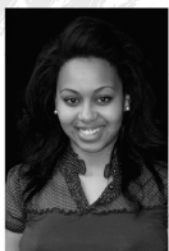
SUSIE MOHR (DIANE)

KAGISO ALICIA PAYNTER (IVY)

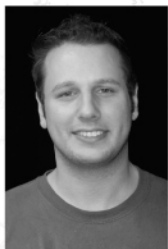

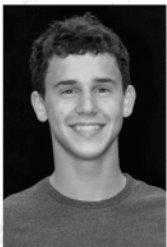
